There is a WINTER STORM WATCH IN EFFECT FROM THURSDAY AFTERNOON THROUGH LATE THURSDAY NIGHT ABOVE 6000 FEET for the Kaibab Plateau and Eastern Mogollon Rim. Daisy Mountain Area Weather will be see a 30 percent chance of showers, mainly after 5pm. Increasing clouds, with a high near 73. Breezy, with an east wind 5 to 15 mph

- Northbound and Southbound I-17 will have nightly alternating left and right lane closures between Anthem Way and Sunset Point. Sections of either left or right lanes will be closed nightly. Drivers should expect delays through June 17th.

I-10 South of Phoenix

- Shoulder closed on I-10 Eastbound from Maricopa Pinal County Line MP 171 to MP173 until 3/21/2025 5:00 AM

I-10 West of Phoenix

- Single line traffic alternating directions on I-10 Westbound from Salome Rd (MP 80) to La Paz Maricopa County Line (MP 70) . Lanes Alternating. Width Restriction: 14ft. Until 3/12/2025 6:00 AM

US-60 East of Phoenix

- Construction work on US-60 Eastbound from MP 61.5 to MP 62.5 . Lanes Alternating. Width Restriction: 12ft until 5/16/2025.
